DIRECTIONS TO WILD IRIS RIDGE

From Hwy 126/ West 11th St. in Eugene (near the Council office):

Go East on West 11th to Bertelsen Rd. Take a RIGHT (south) on Bertelsen. Follow Bertelsen Rd. south approx. 1 ¼ miles. Take a RIGHT where Bertelsen merges with Bailey Hill. Follow Bailey Hill south approx. 1/2 mile. Take a LEFT at the second long gravel driveway on the East side of Bailey Hill just past Gimpl Hill Rd. and the Bailey Hill Market. This is just south of 3205 Bailey Hill. The correct driveway has a long pole fence on the north side of the driveway and a house to the south. Go east up the driveway and keep RIGHT at the split. Park near the yellow gate.
